Carobana Confectionary. Watch them make Carob Coated Products, Honeycombe Products, Rocky Road and Nut Brittles. Entry is free, you can talk to the confectioners and maybe get a free sample. Products for Sale.

The Clog Barn. Watch a free Clog Making demonstration, stroll through a miniature Dutch Village with working Railway. This is a great spot for lunch at Big Oma's Coffee House.

The Honey Place. See the bees building a hive. Has a giftshop and small nursery. Their Coffee shop serves Tea, Coffee and scones.

Sealy Lookout is near the Big Banana and has beautiful views over Coffs, better done in the afternoon.

The Wildlife Sanctuary. This is a great day out. They have penguins, fish, rays & sharks, sea lions, turtles & dolphins. There are 9 half hour talks starting at 9.15 am. Entrance prices are reasonable at \$35 up to 20 and \$30 for over 20. Their morning & afternoon tea and lunch menu's are very reasonable. We are having this visit before Thursday so you can return on Thursday to have a personal visit with the animals. Costs a lot more.

The North Coast Regional Botanic Gardens. These gardens are only small in hectares, you could walk around them in about 2 hours. If you can't walk that far then they provide an 8 seater "golf cart" to provide a taxi service within the park. They have a nice café that provides tea, coffee and light lunches. There is plenty of room to sit and recover within the park. The Gardens were recently on "Better Homes and Gardens" on Chanel 7.
